WHAT IS RADON? WHY SHOULD I CARE?



- A radioactive gas that is clear and odorless
- Radon is a silent killer
- Causes lung damage and cancer
- There is no cure for radon poisoning


WHAT CAN I DO ABOUT IT?





- Test for radon
- Notify your landlord if a problem is present
- Get the problem fixed



HOW DOES IT GET INTO MY PLACE?

- Radon is in the soil
 - Seeps through cracks, walls, and drains into apartments or house
